### **Breakfast / After School Club**

Our breakfast and after school club will continue to run as normal for the rest of this term.

From September 2018 we have some new and exciting themes to introduce. Our breakfast club will remain the same, from 8am-9am including breakfast, at a cost of £2 per session and from 8.30am-9am (no breakfast) at a cost of £1 per session.

Our after school club will have three themed evenings per week:-

These clubs will run from 3.15pm-4.15pm at a cost of £3 per session. After school care is available on all days until 5.15pm. If you require after school care on the night a themed club is being run this will continue until 5.15pm and is chargeable at £5.50 for the whole session (3.15-5.15pm) and includes a snack. On Thursday and Friday children can choose/bring in their own activities (within reason – no electronic devices please). The cost of running these clubs covers any ingredients/resources required for the activity.

We will review these activities on a termly basis, changing themes to suit children's interests.
